Resignation Letter

To all Big Sky Mineral Resources Phase I contributors,

I am writing to inform that I am resigning from being a managing member of Big Sky Mineral Resources, LLC (BSMR) effective this Friday, September 7, 2018. Due to the government restraining order on BSMR throughout the period that I have been a managing member, all BSMR assets, books, accounts and records have been frozen and inaccessible.

While I had hopes of being able to do something on behalf of BSMR, I was never able to accomplish anything due to the government's restraining order, which was extended until further notice of the court. As of today, that restraining order remains in full force and effect to the best of my knowledge. So, at no time was there anything that I could do as a managing member with all accounts and actions of BSMR frozen by the government. During the government restraining order, all previous BSMR oil and gas leases expired while no actions at BSMR could be taken.

As part of Kevin's recent conviction, the government will seek to recover whatever assets of the company may exist on behalf of all BSMR contributors, rendering the role of managing member powerless in the future. It also means that we are all dependent upon government officials to recover any BSMR assets on behalf of all contributing BSMR members.

Before I officially resign, I believe it is in the best interest of all BSMR contributing members to report to state officials all known criminal activities by individuals other than Kevin Moore, all of whom contributed to the demise of BSMR and the loss of our contributions. These individuals should all be investigated as well and put in line as potential sources from whom we may one day recover any of our losses. This would be my only act as managing member of BSMR.

I would like to know if you would like me to file a criminal report on individuals who clearly contributed to our losses. Please respond immediately with your decision as to whether I should file that report with an investigative body on behalf of all BSMR contributors before the effective date of my resignation.

Filing this report may serve to help any future civil suits in an attempt to recover our losses. I will need to know by this Friday to file as a managing member. Responses after this date will not be useful. If the complaint is filed, I will send a copy of the complaint to this same email distribution.

I am hopeful that this action may open additional avenues for recovery of our financial losses, through other responsible parties. Please also respond with your decision as quickly as possible. Responses after noon Friday September 7, 2018 will not be considered.
